Guava, mandarin zest and blossoms weave together seamlessly. Creamy, textured mouthfeel, with lingering fresh fruit ending with a clean bite.

REGIONAL TROPHY: RED RHONE VARIETAL UNDER £15 Viña Mayu, Syrah Reserva, Elqui Valley

THIS IS A Chilean wine with an Italian accent and a French designer suit. The Olivier family, originally from northern Italy, are local

landowners who teamed up with flying winemaker Giorgio Flessati (pictured right) and diversified from fruit and pisco production into wine in the late 1990s. It was an inspired move: their Syrahs in particular were stunning from the start; their peppery, floral, meaty tones reminiscent of northern Rhône. Mayu was established in 2005 as a sister winery to Falernia, making wines in a similarly extrovert, elegant fashion.

A good deal of work has been done since those early days in terms of defining the best Syrah plots and vineyards within the valley. Some of the best and most thrilling Syrah fruit in this winery comes from the Quebrada de Talca site, at the entrance to the valley proper, 18km from the coast. The local conditions mean mornings are often foggy, maturation slow, and flavours both complex and invigorating. A small amount of fruit

from warmer sites further up the valley gives the blend extra succulence, spice and breadth.

This Trophy was the most hotly contested of this year's DWWA: a total of six wines were battling it out for this Regional gong (and exactly half of them from Falernia/Mayu). Not just that, but this is the fourth year in a row that a Syrah from this outfit has won a Regional Trophy. Kudos to them. PR
